The farm features the largest private beach on Kent Island, and 107 acres to run, explore and have fun. The setting is perfect for an epic

game of Capture the Flag. In exchange for use of this historic property, we will spend a couple of hours doing beach cleanup. There will also be opportunities to work on merit badges such as swimming, personal fitness and others.

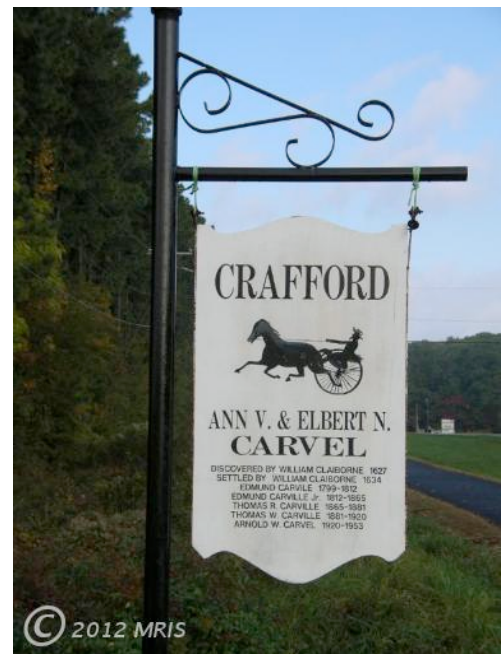
### Activities:
