Overview: On Saturday we will visit King's Dominion amusement park in Virginia. Attractions include a replica of the Eiffel Tower, theaters, and classic rides like the log flume, river raft, ferris wheel, carousel, drop tower, swing tower, top spin, scrambler, and a roller coaster. Okay, not just one roller coaster. Eleven roller coasters, or maybe more. Too many to count!

Saturday night we'll camp at the King's Dominion campground and Sunday we'll spend some time in camp before heading home.

Assemble: 7:00am on Saturday at CCUMC

Return: 2pm on Sunday at CCUMC

Cost: \$48.75 per participant for admission, camping fees, and transportation. Plus money for lunch and dinner in the park.

Food: Saturday: Lunch and dinner in the park. Sunday breakfast: patrol cooking. Bring money for fast food on Sunday on the way home.

Weather: The historical averages are lows in the 40s and highs around 70°. Of course, it can be warmer or colder. Use sunscreen.



What to Bring for the Park:

Cell phones are encouraged. Cell phones and electronics are allowed on the car ride and in King's Dominion, but not while camping. If you bring your cell phone, be sure it is charged.

Money for lunch, dinner, snacks and incidentals.

What to Bring for Camping:

We are car camping, so we'll have access to the vehicles.

Tenting is by patrol. Make sure you know where you are sleeping.
