

Hi all:

Troop 255 is heading to Timberline (<http://timberlineresort.com/>) on Feb 13th for a ski/board weekend. We will be skiing both Saturday and Sunday and returning Sunday evening. The cost of the trip is \$209 including: 2 nights bunkhouse lodging, 2 day lift ticket (Sat. & Sun. includes night skiing), and 5 meals! For skiers, they also throw in a 2 day ski rental and a beginner lesson if you need it.

Details: Timberline is a great ski/board destination within about 3 hours of DC, with 39 slopes (one 2 miles long), glade skiing, and 2 terrain parks. Lodging is bunkhouse style - there is a boy's bunk room and a girl's bunk room. It's very close to the lodge, so the scouts can move between lodge/slope/bunkhouse/meals without needing a vehicle. Families/siblings are welcome in the lodges. (There is other lodging families can elect to stay in as well on your own if the bunkhouse is too rough and ready - you are on your own to arrange that).

I need a count ASAP to firmly reserve our spots (including a 50% deposit). This is a holiday weekend so the spots are in demand - we have already put in a small deposit and a hold but now need to confirm. Could you please RSVP here if you are coming, including your scout name, and let me know how many siblings/parents will also be staying in the bunk house? Please let me know how many men vs women in the comments.
