

We'd like to encourage you to **put Tuesday, February 17 on your calendar in Mardi Gras purple, green, and gold because we hope every Scout will be able to take a two-hour shift at the dinner** (with time off to enjoy pancakes, sausages, fruit, and ice cream themselves).

The shifts are roughly

4:30 to 6:30 (set-up + eating + 1 hour of serving our guests, including church and community members and Scout families)

OR

6:30 to 8:30 (eating + 1 hour of serving + clean-up)

and we ask that **all Scouts wear white shirts and black pants to the Pancake Supper.**

The regular troop meeting before the event (Tuesday, February 10) will be devoted to fun activities that will help the guys learn and practice the skills they'll need to serve on the night of the supper.

(This counts as an activity for rank advancement - Second Class Requirement 3 & First Class Requirement 3)
